John can do or get anything you could ever need or want. Just ask him - and don't take no for an answer.

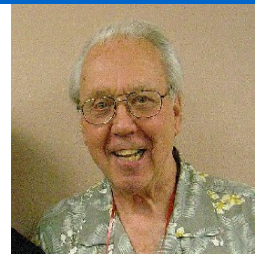

Policies Rules, Guidelines and Miscellaneous

Cell Phones - Must be turned off while games are in play. Directors will assess penalties.

Cell phones take messages when off. Here's an announcement I like. "Hi, Sorry I'm not available to take your call. I'm taking some intensive classes on how to eliminate negative influences in my life. Please leave your name and number at the beep, and I'll get back to you at my earliest convenience. If I don't call, you're one of them. Have a great day."

Lost and Found - See Tournament Directors.

If you've lost the bag supplied at the registration Desk and put stuff in it that you don't need, you have four choices. 1).
